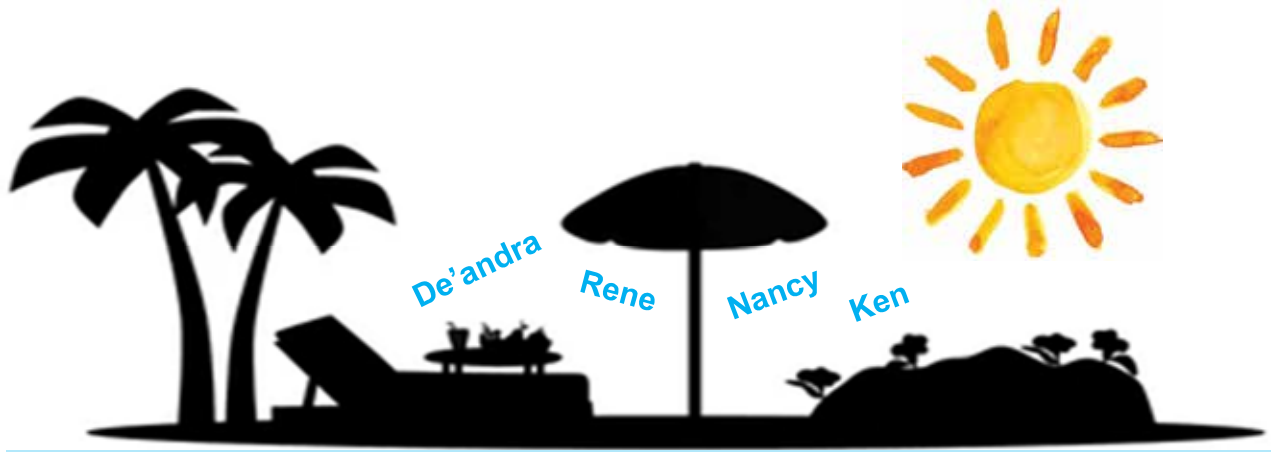
Keepin' You Posted" with the RCE Post Office Team

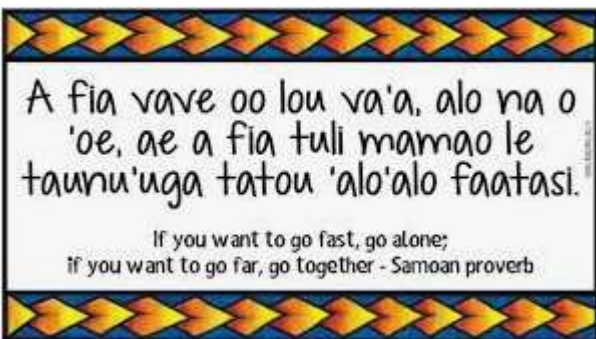

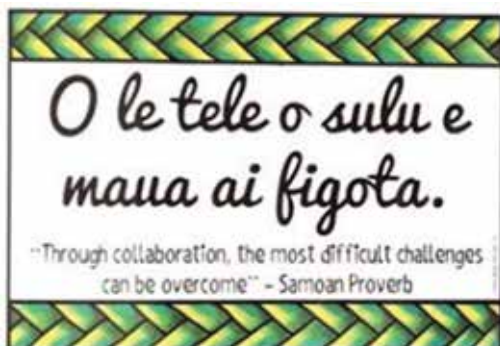
The A-Team in the Activities Office always needs extra help! If you'd like to volunteer, come and see us. We pay in tickets and fun!

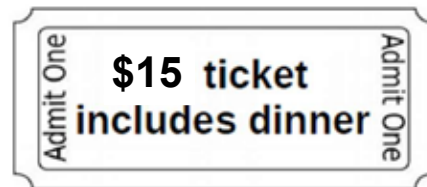

AED Device

Safety from Wildlife

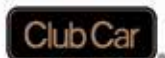

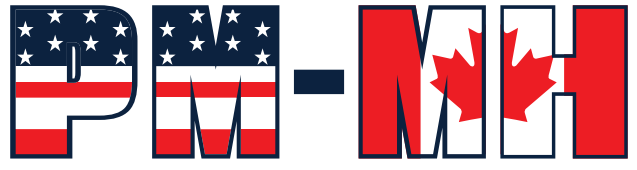
