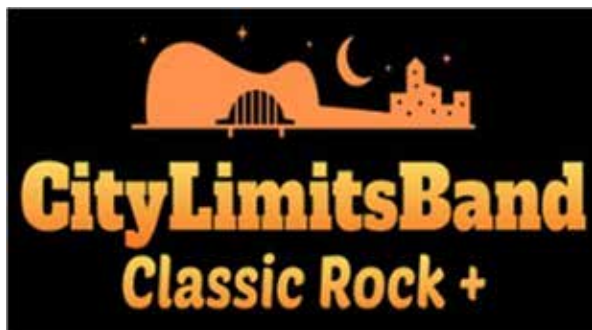

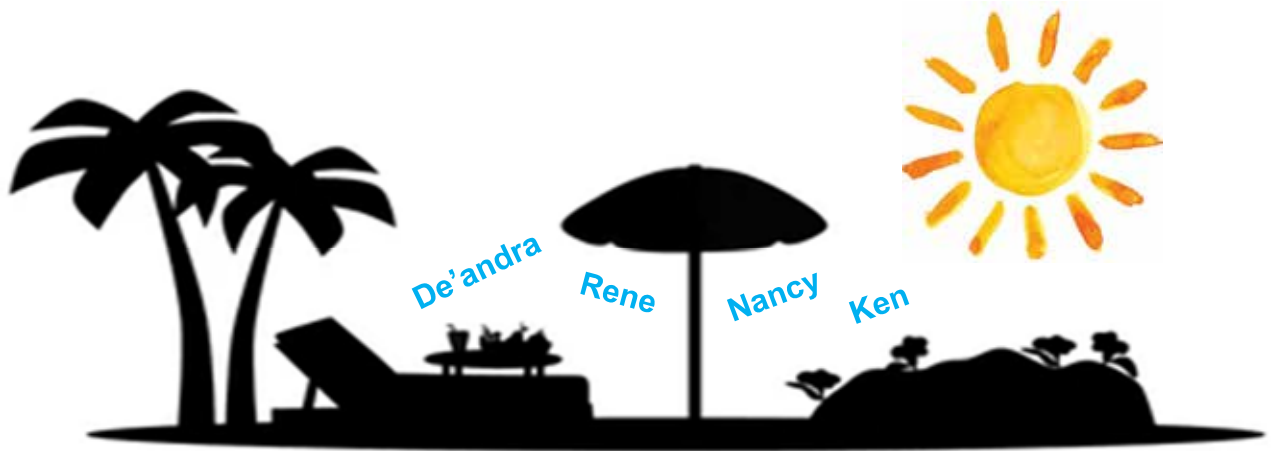
“Keepin’ You Posted” with the RCE Post Office Team

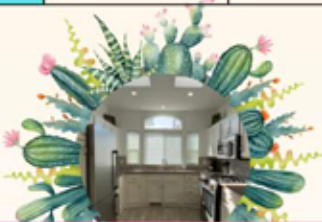



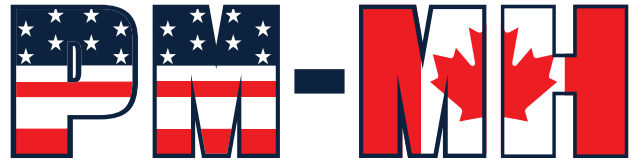
